



HOW TO APPLY FOR A STUDY ABROAD PROGRAM

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Once you've decided on the perfect program for you, click the 'Apply Now' button near the top of that program's page. Doing so will begin your application in our system.

- If an "Apply Now" button does not appear under the first section of the page, then unfortunately that program is not currently allowing applications. It could be too early for you to apply, or too late. If you have questions, you can always ask the Study Abroad office.

If you are a UF student, click the first option, "I have a GatorLink username and password", to login. *(If you are a Non-UF student, please refer to [this webpage](#) for application instructions from this point forward.)* Upon logging in, you will be asked to choose which **term** you'd like to participate in the program. Some programs will only have one option; some will have multiple.

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Once in the application, you will see three different types of requirements:

- **Material Submissions** (including payment of our Administrative Charge/Deposit)
- **Application Questionnaires** (items where a bit more information is required from you, such as the Medical History Questionnaire and the Payment Questionnaire)
- **Signature Documents** (forms that you need to read, understand, and digitally sign)

Depending on the specific program you have chosen, there may be additional requirements such as an Academic Advising Form, Resume, or Essay. If you have questions about this, please contact the Program Director or your Study Abroad Advisor.

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Once everything listed within your application portal has been completed and checked off, and any additional requirements set forth by your Program Director have been met (for an example, an interview), your application is complete.

- If you are applying to a **UF Sponsored** program, the Program Director or your Study Abroad Advisor can tell you how applications are reviewed. Some programs accept students on a first-come, first-served basis, while others wait until a set deadline to review all students and make selections.
- If you are applying to a **UF Exchange** program, your Study Abroad Advisor will now nominate you to your host university. After that, your host university will inform you about their next steps, which may include a separate application process, course registration, and/or housing selection.
- If you are applying to a **Non-UF** program, please note that you will also need to apply with the third-party provider or institution running it. They will have an entirely separate application process, which we encourage you to work on at the same time as ours.
